Junior Counselor/Counselor-in-Training Responsibilities

GENERAL FUNCTION:

The Junior Counselor (JC)/Counselor-in-Training (CIT) will assist the counselor to whom assigned and share leadership responsibilities with the entire camp staff.

SKILLS:

- JC entering 7th or 8th grade in the fall, CIT entering 9th,10th,11th,12th grade
- Enthusiastic and cooperative
- Enjoys children and the outdoors
- Is responsible and trustworthy

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Arrive at 7:30 a.m. Monday morning for training on the weeks you are assigned.
- Students entering 7th grade in the fall may volunteer for preschool camp only. Those entering 8th grade may volunteer for two weeks.
- To be punctual, arriving at the YMCA by 8:30 a.m. each day.
- To be dependable if needed to supervise the campers for short periods of time.
- To teach campers flag ceremony procedures and assist in leading ceremonies.
- To set good examples and be a positive influence on the campers.
- To maintain an enthusiastic attitude and appropriate behavior.
- To assist with song leading on the bus.
- Be aware and concerned for safety matters.

REMINDERS:

- Your assistance is needed throughout the day and night (when assisting with overnights). This includes locker room supervision, swimming, and overnights...morning activities at the YMCA too!
- Lunch is not a social activity. Share it with the campers as well as the staff.
- Junior Counselors are expected to attend and assist with Family Night activities.
- Only those assigned to an overnight group will stay over. Only two Junior Counselors of the same gender are allowed to a tent.
- Junior Counselors are required to wear a staff t-shirt on Monday and Thursday night (Family Night). Junior Counselors are expected to dress appropriately.
