Qualifications

- Must be able to pass a background check.

- Certifications: CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, Basic First Aid.
- Certifications: Lifeguard preferred.
- Ability to maintain certification-level of physical and mental readiness.
- Ability to respond to safety and emergency situations and to make solid decisions under pressure.
- Previous experience of 6 months instructing lessons or coaching preferred.

General Essential Functions

- 1. Adhere to job safety practices and risk management protocols per the Employee Handbook and Emergency Response Plan, including child abuse prevention standards and mandated abuse reporting requirements, to create and maintain a safe and secure environment for all.
- 2. Perform excellent service to all members, staff, volunteers and guests.

3. Perform other related duties as assigned by your supervisor or other Leadership staff.

Role Specific Functions

- 1. Implement practice lesson plans focused on development of competitive strokes, starts, turns and team skills as well as intangible values of teamwork, persistence, positive attitude, etc.
- 2. Build effective, authentic relationships with participants and parents; help them connect with each other and the YMCA.
- 3. Ensure compliance to program guidelines regarding relay entry, practice attendance, sportsmanship, etc.
- 4. Maintain records as required (i.e. attendance, skill evaluation, etc.)
- 5. Attend staff meetings and trainings as scheduled.
- 6. Follow all YMCA policies, rules, regulation and procedures, including emergency safety procedures. Complete incident and accident reports as necessary.
- 7. Maintain and secure team equipment. Report damaged equipment or facility safety concerns.
- 8. May provide instruction or demonstration in the pool.

Physical Demands

Ability to perform all physical aspects of the position including: walk, stand, bend, reach, lift, use hands to manipulate objects, talk, hear and see. Ability to lift up to 50 pounds to assist or remove individuals from the water. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
